- A) High School assessment is required of all 11th grade students who did not pass as 10th graders in 2009-10. 9th and 10th graders may also take the assessment, as can 12th graders who haven't yet passed.
- B) Three online testing opportunities per school year. Students taking OAKS Braille may not be given access to OAKS Online.
- C) Required test for students in grades 3 through 8 and in High School.
- D) Both English-only and English-Spanish formats are available.
- E) Online testing will be suspended on 11/26/10 and 3/18/11 due to ODE furlough days.
- F) Required test for students in grades 5, 8, and in High School.
- G) Optional test for students in grades 5, 8, and in High School. Each student has two online testing opportunities in social sciences per school year.
- H) Data for students tested on or after 5/1/11 will be in student staging by 7/15/11.

- I) Available for students whose IEP or 504 Plan requires OAKS Braille, or in situations where the school district documents a student exception. There is one testing opportunity per school year. Students taking OAKS Braille may not be given access to OAKS Online.
- J) Students at the High School level are only allowed one writing test opportunity, either during the winter or spring window, and either Online or Paper administration. Beginning in 2012, 12th graders only may test in both windows. No extensions for the writing window or ship date will be granted.
- K) If the applicable postmark or data entry deadline is missed, students will be counted as non-participants
- L) Districts must provide the opportunity for all 10th grade students to take the PSAT/NMSQT® except in districts with waiver.
- M) Pending availability of state resources
- N) Districts may only administer one opportunity per student between 10/13/10 and 1/3/11.
